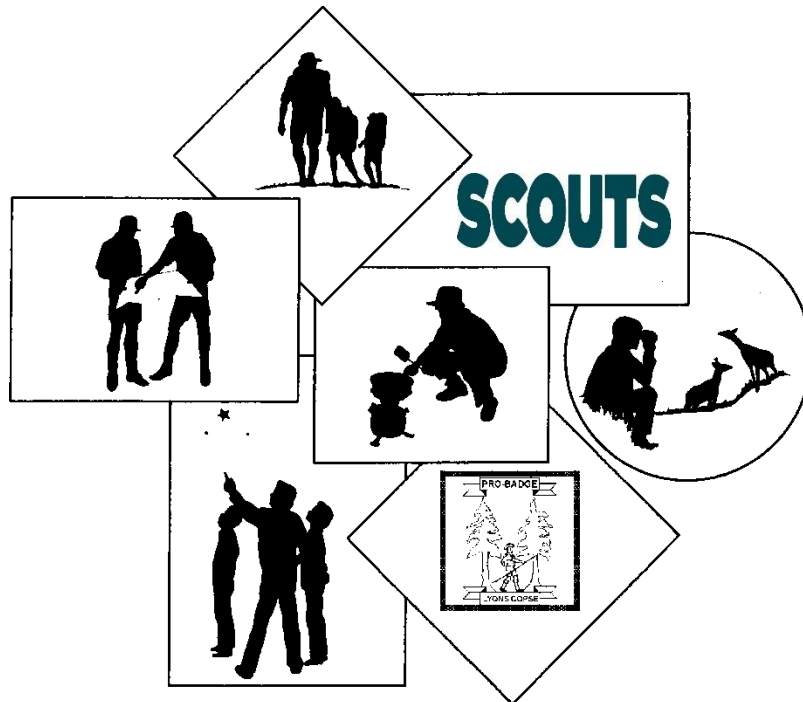

What is Pro-Badge?

It is Scout badge courses run by qualified volunteer leaders. Pro-Badge is an Activity Badge Training Scheme, which uses the resources of the Solent Scout Training Centre, to the best advantage of the Cub Scouts, Scouts, and Scout Leaders. The scheme provides training for badges that predominantly require outdoor Scouting activity or natural resources.

Facilities

Scout courses are held in Pines Cabin where there is hot and cold running water and flush toilets. Unless the course requirements dictate otherwise e.g. Camper, Survival Skills, and Chef courses, all meals are cooked by the cook house.

Cost

The cost for Scout courses is £40.00 per weekend. This will be reduced to £35.00 if paid in full to Pro-Badge at least two weeks before the start of the course. The price includes all training, food and accommodation for the weekend.

Record of Achievement

Records of Achievements have been produced for all Scout Activity Badges and are designed to indicate the areas that a Scout has either passed or is yet to achieve. Records of Achievements are also designed to help leaders within their troop to understand what the Scout has been doing.

Chef

Create a menu, light your own fire and then cook several meals, but don't forget the washing up afterwards. You can earn this badge twice in one weekend both outdoors and inside.



Pioneer

Learn new knots and lashings and then put them into practise by building a large pioneer structure. Then you can make good use of them by climbing all over.



Forester

Learn all about how different woodlands are managed and how to use an axe and saw. Learn to identify and how to transplant young trees.



Expedition Challenge

Enjoy two challenging and interesting cross country hikes using map and compass skills. You also need to complete a project about the area you are visiting

This course takes **two** weekends to complete. Minimum age 12 years OR 11 years if have passed Navigator Stage 3.



Navigator - Stage 3

Learn to navigate using a map and compass. Enjoy a long hike whilst trying not to get lost. This is an ideal badge for **younger** scouts and a good introduction to scout Pro-Badge.



Camper

Pitch your tent, camp under canvas for 2 nights, cook a meal and learn how to make various camp gadgets.

15 nights away under canvas as a Scout is required to achieve this badge, but it is not a pre requisite to attending the course.



Survival Skills

Spend a night in the shelter you have built. Build a fire to keep yourself warm, learn what plants are safe to eat and how to skin a rabbit.

Minimum age 12 years.
