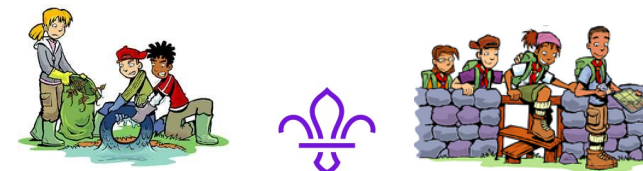

What is Pro-Badge?

Pro-Badge is an Activity Badge Training Scheme, which uses the resources of the Solent Scout Training Centre, run by qualified volunteer leaders, for the best advantage of the Cubs, Scouts, Explorers and Leaders. The scheme provides training for badges that predominantly require outdoor Scouting activity or natural resources.

Facilities

Scout and Explorer courses are held in Pine Cabin where there is hot and cold running water and flush toilets. Unless the course requirements dictate otherwise e.g. Camper, Survival Skills, and Chef courses, all meals are home made, with dietary requirements catered for, and cooked by the cook house.

What else will I get out of the weekend?

Fun packed activities that help the young people to gain independence, confidence, and make new friends. More nights to add to your Nights Away badge. Maybe even a hike to add to your Hikes Away badge.



Scouts

Pioneer



Learn new knots and lashings and then put them into practise by building a large pioneer structure. Then you can make good use of them by climbing all over.

Chef



Create a menu, light your own fire and then cook several meals, but don't forget the washing up afterwards.

Expedition Challenge



Enjoy two challenging and interesting cross country hikes using map and compass skills. You will also need to complete a project about the area you are visiting. This course takes **two** weekends to complete.

Minimum age 12 years OR 11 years if you have passed Navigator Stage 3.

Forester



Learn all about how different woodlands are managed and how to use an axe and saw. Learn to identify and how to transport and plant young trees.

Navigator - Stage 3



Learn to navigate using a map and compass. Enjoy a long hike whilst trying not to get lost. This is an ideal badge for **younger** Scouts and a good introduction to Scout Pro-Badges.

Camper



Pitch your tent, camp under canvas for 2 nights, cook a meal and learn how to make various camp gadgets. 15 nights away as a Scout is required to achieve this badge, but is not a pre-requisite to attending the course.
